- Meet all admission standards established in the General Catalog.
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.50 in high school or place of origin.
- To be eligible for third year courses, must have successfully completed the requirements of the first two years of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing from a recognized and accredited institution of higher education. Candidates who bring an associate degree must complete all general education requirement established by the institution.
- Present at the moment of the admission to the program evidence of a permanent license acquired.

REQUISITES FOR CLINICAL PRACTICE AGENCY

- Certificate of negative criminal record issued by the Police Department of Puerto Rico.
- Health certificate valid for one year issued by the Department of Health of Puerto Rico.
- Evidence for Hepatitis B-Vaccines.
- Evidence of varicella (chickenpox) or varicella titers.
- Some agencies and courses have additional requirements, such as: current CPR certification, negative doping test, nose and throat culture, negative certification of sex offender.
