According to answers to the telephone interview of completers (Instrument ET-14), which was posted on Survey Monkey, all are gainfully employed (100%), and 8 work as teachers (73%); 10 (91%) have passed the Teacher Certification Test (PCMAS); 10 acquired their jobs in the first 6 months since graduation (91%); and 2 have emigrated to the USA (2%). The completers who chose not to pursue work as teachers explained that they had financial needs and teaching salary was not high enough. They work in other fields and/or private corporations.
