

Admission Requirements

Comply with the general admission requirements for a master's degree, established by the Inter-American University of Puerto Rico in its current Graduate Catalog.

Comply with the following specific program requirements:

- Have completed a bachelor's degree from an accredited university with an academic index of 3.0 or more.
- Have taken the following courses*:
 - Biological Sciences
 - Physical Sciences
 - Social Sciences
 - Statistics

*** These courses must be approved with a grade not lower than B prior to requesting admission to the Program.**

Master of Science in
Speech and
Language Pathology





The program is **Quarterly** designed to offer courses at night. With a duration of **two and a half years**. New students will be admitted in **August and March**. The curricular design consists of 19 core credits and 40 specialized credits in Speech and Language Pathology. For a total of **59 credits**.

The Speech-Language Pathologist is the health professional who provides assessment and treatment services to people with speech, language and swallow problems. During their academic and clinical preparation, the student of our program will be able to develop skills and competencies based on empirical evidence, become familiar with instrumentation and related technology in the management of the population they will attend once they graduate. The graduate of the program may work as a Speech-Language Pathologist in infant care centers, schools, private clinics, rehabilitation centers, hospitals, among others. Even our graduates will be prepared to work in Puerto Rico and the United States.

Applicants to this program must:

- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of them from a teacher.
- Have obtained a minimum score of 400 points on the EXADEP test (five years or less after taking it).
- Essay.
- Professional resume.
- Admission interview with a designated faculty committee.
- Submit an official transcript from the university of origin.
- Complete the application for admission and submit it within the deadline.
